

Aging Solutions Board of Trustees Member Role

The mission of Aging Solutions is to support the health and safety of vulnerable older adults and people with disabilities and help keep them living independently at home.

The purpose of Aging Solutions is to provide goods and services to support and sustain individuals enrolled in Central Ohio Area Agency on Aging (COAAA) programs in the eight-county service area to include Delaware, Fairfield, Fayette, Franklin, Licking, Madison, Pickaway and Union counties. Aging Solutions emergency financial assistance for one-time rent, security deposits, and utilities, as well as household and medical goods and services, safety repairs, microwaves, vacuums, space heaters, and other essential support.

The Aging Solutions board is responsible for

- Provide financial oversight and prudent use of resources
- Ensure adequate financial resources
- Elect officers and approve staff liaisons/ designees from Central Ohio Area Agency on Aging

The Aging Solutions Board of Trustees shall hold at least three (3) meetings a year, one of which is the annual meeting being held on a date designated by the Board of Trustees or, in the absence of such designation, in November of each year.

Terms of office of the Trustees shall be a staggered three (3) year term with renewal by approval of the board.
